Northall Village Hall Solar Panel Presentation	Cllr Cubbage gave a comprehensive presentation detailing the recent Solar Panel Project at Northall Village Hall. Following the presentation Cllr Cubbage explained that due to the orientation of Edlesborough Memorial Hall, the close proximity of the trees and the Government's proposed drastic reductions in the Feed In Tariffs effective in January 2016, the feasibility of installing solar panels at Edlesborough Memorial Hall does not look possible under the current circumstances. The Full Council agreed with this recommendation.	
Open Forum	New TreesEDaN Beautification presented a tree planting plan for Edlesborough Green. This included one Service tree near thePebblemoor car park, three oak trees on the High Street side of the Green and a Christmas Tree.Approval was given for all six trees with the provision that final locations are agreed with MW Agri to ensure adequatespace is available between the trees and the boundary hedge. Council agreed that the Christmas Tree should belocated near to Sue and John Parker's tree so that it can be viewed from the road.Action: Clerk to share plan with MW Agri and ensure location is agreed. Neighbourhood Plan	 Cllr Williams gave a comprehensive presentation on the Funding of the Neighbourhood Plan Project Plan. A quote from rCOH for their support. The cost is £11,000 for 22 days support. A grant of up to £8000 can be applied for. Cllr Williams proposed that the Council organise two meetings in each village as soon as practicable; one meeting on a weekday evening and another on a Saturday afternoon subject to hall availability in Edlesborough, Dagnall and Northall. The purpose of the meetings will be to explain what we are trying to do and to get people to volunteer for the Steering Group we need to set up and to join the sub-groups. The Neighbourhood Plan is an opportunity to define a Strategic Plan for the parish for the next 15 years. 					
	Cllr Williams proposed a delay launching the Neighbourhood Plan to January, thereby hoping to ensure good community engagement which is vital for the Neighbourhood Plan. The Full Council agreed with this proposal. <i>Action: Cllr Williams will prepare a statement for inclusion in the next edition of Focus by Nov 10th</i>					

Devolution	Bucks CC are continuing with their Devolution strategy. EPC will look into extending the current contractors contract for grass cutting to include other areas in the Parish including Public Footpaths, and the footpath in Dagnall Allotments. Action: Understand the legal requirements of Bucks CC Devolution contract. Create a plan of all the grass areas/footpaths etc. to go to contractor for a quote. TFB have repaired some of the pot holes at the ford, the rest currently do not meet the criteria for repairs. The twisted speed limit sign near the Travellers rest has been reported & is still twisted. The poor condition and failing lights and bollards at the Travellers Rest roundabout were escalated to Stuart Labroth. The closure of the A4146 on Monday 28th October caused lots of traffic issues in the village, particularly in the early evening.
