#### Annual Return

Edlesborough Parish Council approved and signed a new Code of Conduct on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2012.

## **Traffic Calming**

Bucks CC are being constantly chased up regarding the painting of road roundels and repairs to the VAS 30mph sign in Northall together with the removal of redundant poles etc. remaining in situ following the Speed Limit Review and work that is required to the pot holes throughout the parish.

#### **Expansion Plans for Luton Airport**

Luton Airport's operating company has published a Master Plan to show how they intend to develop the airport to increase flights and consequent passenger throughput by up to 80% from 10m to 18m passengers per annum. The second, competing, planning application that had been expected from Luton Borough Council (which owns the airport freehold) will not now be submitted.

#### Litter Bin Recycling

Following the introduction of the new recycling scheme in Aylesbury Vale District Council area parishioners are reminded that only the bins will be emptied and anything that is left beside the bins in black sacks or loose will not be collected.

Buckinghamshire's Household Waste recycling centres will be changing to winter opening hours. From 1<sup>st</sup> October to March 31 2013 the sites will be open from 9am to 5pm daily, except for Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day.
