Annual Parish Meeting

On 18th April the Annual Parish Meeting was held at Edlesborough Memorial Hall. Five parishioners attended. The meeting consisted of a report from the Council Chairman and a summary of the Council's financial position.

No questions were asked by Parishioners.

County Cllr Anne Wight

Cllr Wight attended the April EPC meeting, her full report can be found on the EPC Website. Cllr Wight reported on

District Cllr Chris Poll

Cllr Poll attended the April EPC meeting he reported that as promised he had raised questions about the lack of a decision on the Swallowfields planning application. He will continue to press Council on this matter. Cllr Poll explained that issues with planning applications are not unique to Edlesborough, there are similar instances right across the Vale. Cllr Poll had been reluctant to ask for the prioritising of any particular application but now feels he must make as much noise as he can to achieve a decision on the Swallowfields planning application.

Grass Verges

Three years ago Bucks CC devolved the cutting of the grass verges in the 30mph limit in the three villages to EPC. Last year EPC extended this grass cutting to include the verges in the 40mph limit ensuring greater consistency across the villages. EPC will be continuing with providing this service to the Parish.

EPC requests that parishioners **do not** park their vehicles on the grass verges as this results in damage to the verges and prevents the contractor from cutting the grass.

Grass & Hedge Cutting in the Villages

Now that the spring time has arrived the cutting of the grass verges has resumed. EPC requests that parishioners do not park on the grass verges as this causes damage to them and inconveniences the contractors.

EPC asks all parishioners whose hedges boarder the pavements to ensure that their hedges are kept well-trimmed ensuring that the maximum pavement width is available for pedestrians, pushchair and wheelchair users.

The hedge known as The Pastures hedge is scheduled to be cut by EPC's contractor in the last week of June/first week of July (this work is weather dependent).

Best Kept Village Competition

Edlesborough has once again entered the Buckinghamshire Best Kept Village Competition, judging will take place between 1st June and 7th July 2019.

Our volunteer litter picking teams have been out and about in the villages recently collecting over 17 sacks of rubbish during one pick. EPC thanks the volunteers for all their hard work. Anyone wishing to get involved with the
