## Buckinghamshire Best Kept Village Competition

Edlesborough once again entered the Bucks Best Kept Village Competition. Unfortunately the village did not win but we did get a certificate of Merit. The village scored 91/100 with the winning village scoring 95/100.

The judges made the following comments & awarded marks as follows:

## <u>Principal features</u>

Cemetery, graveyard – very well kept	10/10
Playing field and children's play area – well kept	18/20
Floral displays – generally some good floral displays – perhaps could have been a few more	4/5
Area around village hall is very good	10/10
General environmental features – good	8/10
<u>Other features</u>	
The areas around the shops and pub were pretty good – some weeds around a couple of the	9/10
shops. The Travellers Rest pub was particularly good with its floral displays in focus.	
Bus stops, bus shelters and noticeboards – Good	9/10
War Memorial – Well kept	10/10
Overall appearance, lack of litter and evidence of community effort – Good, a few bits of litter	13/15
and weeds in verges/gutters noted, and some more floral displays would have given the overall	
appearance a "boost

#### **Allotments**

The annual allotment rent for 2019/20 is due to be paid at the start of October 2019. The rent due is £2 per pole.

EPC requests that rents are paid by internet banking or cheque (made payable to Edlesborough Parish Council). Should any tenants require the Council's bank details please contact the Clerk.



In order for the Parish Council to save on administration expenses it would be very much appreciated if tenants could pay either by internet banking or send a cheque to the Edlesborough Parish Clerk. Please ensure rent is paid by 11th October 2019, late payments will incur a £10 administration fee.

EPC currently has plots available at our Dagnall and The Green sites, with short waiting lists at the Northall and Cow Lane sites. Anyone wishing to take on an allotment should contact the Clerk. Fees are £2 per pole and plots range in size from 5-10 poles.

#### Streetlights

## **Hedge Cutting**

The parish council asks parishioners to ensure that the planting around the boundaries of their properties does not cause a danger or inconvenience to others.

Hedges, trees and shrubs must not overhang a highway or any other road or footway to which the public has access to so as to endanger or obstruct the passage of vehicles or pedestrians, or obstructs or interferes with the view of drivers or vehicles or the light from a public lamp, overhangs a highway so as to endanger or obstruct the passage of horse-riders.



## Speedwatch & EDaN Traffic Management
