•	Wipe down any used tables and chairs	
•	Return tables and chairs to the store room	
	- Please stack the tables and chairs as directed; failure to do so causes	
	inconvenience to other users and can lead to Health & Safety issues	
•	Leave the two large un-foldable tables positioned on the right hand side of the	
	hall	
<u>FLOOR</u>		
•	Sweep or vacuum the hall floor after your event – including the entrance hall	
•	A hoover is also available for use if needed, this is stored in the back room	
	through the kitchen area	
<u>HEATING</u>		
•	The thermostat is located above the notice board on the right-hand side of the	
	hall. It can be adjusted 'low/medium/high' or 'off'.	
•	Feel free to set to your desired temperature <u>but ensure it is switched back to</u>	
	<u>'low'</u> on your departure.	
<u>TOILETS</u>		
Ensure		
•	<u>all</u> the toilets are flushed	
•	taps are turned off	
•	the general condition of the toilets is satisfactory for the next user	
•	Check all lights (please double check the toilet cubicles two have individual	
	light switches, one is an automatic sensor light) are switched off.	
•	Empty kitchen waste and recycling bins	
•	Place the black sack along with any other rubbish in the Euro Bin located	
	outside the Memorial Hall. NB if the bin is full, please take your rubbish	
	away with you. The code for the waste bin is on the information sent to	
	you by the hall manager	
•	Replace black sack in the kitchen bin (additional black sacks can be found in the	
_	kitchen drawer under the sink)	
•	Switch off the hot water in the kitchen Turn off the party lights.

•	The oven has been emptied and turned off	
•	Wipe down all work surfaces	
	Ensure no washing up is left behind
